- This Agreement shall be made between All Occasion Music, Inc. and _____, hereinafter known as the **CLIENT, RESIDING AT:** _____

CLIENT EMAIL ADDRESS: _____. The Client agrees to comply with all the terms and conditions stated in this Agreement.
- A non-refundable **DEPOSIT of \$** _____ shall be provided to All Occasion Music, Inc. by the Client as a reservation fee to reserve the following **EVENT DATE:** _____, **EVENT TIME:** _____, and **RECEPTION LOCATION:** _____. The deposit shall go towards the payment of service(s) provided by All Occasion Music, Inc. If the Client decides to cancel the reception for any reason for the date stated in this Agreement, then the reservation fee/deposit is forfeited to All Occasion Music, Inc. and All Occasion Music, Inc. has been deemed to fulfill the obligation under this Agreement.
- The Client also agrees to pay the **BALANCE of \$** _____ 10 days prior to the date stated in item 2 of this Agreement unless otherwise agreed upon and written in this Agreement below. The Client's failure or refusal to pay the above stated compensation to All Occasion Music, Inc., or to the individual Disc Jockey assigned to perform at the event, shall release All Occasion Music, Inc. from furnishing any remaining services to the Client under this Agreement. Refusal to perform under such circumstances shall not constitute breach of Agreement by All Occasion Music, Inc. and its Disc Jockey's whether such unpaid claim shall be in whole or part.
- Additional performance time (above the 4-hour min. rate) will be charged at a rate of \$100.00 per hour if so desired. The first 4 hours will be charged at a rate of \$162.50 per hour. Any additional performance time (Overtime) requested must be paid before or no later than the event date stated in Item 2 of this Agreement.
- Additional early setup time of equipment (more than 1.5 hours) will be charged at a rate of \$50.00 per hour if so desired.
- The Client agrees to pay a \$50.00 service fee for each returned check(s).
- This Agreement is null and void unless a reservation fee/deposit is provided and both All Occasion Music, Inc. and the Client sign this Agreement. This Agreement is also null and void if this Agreement is not returned to All Occasion Music, Inc. By:** _____. The Client understands that the event date will not be held or reserved for the Client unless this Signed Agreement with the reservation fee/deposit is returned to All Occasion Music, Inc. before the date specified here.
- The Client agrees to pay a 15% monthly interest charge on any remaining balances not paid on or before the date stated in this Agreement.
- The Client hereby agrees to pay all costs of collection, including attorney fees to All Occasion Music, Inc. if legal action is instituted by All Occasion Music, Inc. against the Client for breach of Client's responsibilities under this Agreement.
- The Client understands that a standard four-hour reception becomes a minimum eight-hour job for the Disc Jockey and his/her assistant. It is reasonable for the Client to agree to provide a meal for the Disc Jockey and his/her assistant similar to that being served to the guests at your event.
- The Agreement of All Occasion Music, Inc. to perform on the date stated in item 2 is subject to reasonable and good faith detention by the assigned Disc Jockey's illness, accident, Acts of God, or any other legitimate conditions beyond the control of All Occasion Music, Inc. and its Disc Jockeys. If the assigned Disc Jockey is unable to perform at this event the choice of a replacement for performing personnel will be exclusively under the control of All Occasion Music, Inc. Should the Disc Jockey be prevented from performing, once at the event, due to circumstances beyond his/her control (i.e. power failure, schedule conflicts with the reception site, strikes, Acts of God or any other legitimate conditions beyond the control of All Occasion Music, Inc. and its Disc Jockeys) the Disc Jockey and/or All Occasion Music, Inc. shall not be held responsible and will be deemed to have fulfilled his/her obligation under this Agreement.
- If the All Occasion Music, Inc. Disc Jockey should fail to perform at the event for circumstances not beyond his/her control, this shall constitute a breach of Agreement and shall subject All Occasion Music, Inc. to direct liability in damages to the Client for the contracted price of this missed event. This remedy shall constitute the maximum limit of All Occasions Music's liability under any circumstances.
- If the All Occasion Music, Inc. Disc Jockey arrives late (per the specified time in item 2 above) for the event for any reason except for those reasons stated in item 11 of this Agreement, at the Client's option All Occasion Music, Inc. Disc Jockey will either extend the time of the performance by the length of delay or refund any part of lost hour at the contracted price of this event.
- The Client agrees to be responsible for any and all damages to All Occasion Music, Inc. equipment directly resulting from actions at the event which otherwise would not have incurred had services not been contracted for. All Occasion Music, Inc. reserves the right to terminate all services during the event, if any activities or conditions are present that may cause damage to the equipment.
- The Client is NOT responsible for damage to the equipment caused by All Occasion Music, Inc. or by All Occasion Music, Inc. associates. All Occasion Music, Inc. reserves the right to terminate all services during the event, if for any reason the Disc Jockey and associates of All Occasion Music, Inc. feel they are threatened in any way, shape, or form, or due to any activities that may arise during the event that may place the Disc Jockey and associates of All Occasion Music, Inc. in any danger.
- The Client agrees to provide suitable refuge for All Occasion Music, Inc. if the event is to be performed outdoors. The Client understands that there will be high voltage electrical equipment being operated during the event and that it is dangerous to operate the equipment during inclement weather. All Occasion Music, Inc. shall make the decision to turn off all equipment and power during inclement weather to prevent any injury to the guests or to the associates of All Occasion Music, Inc.
- The Client agrees to be responsible for providing or reminding the reception location, the need for a DJ table (approximately 6 to 8 feet long by 2 to 3 feet wide) for the Disc Jockey's equipment. In addition, one standard AC power outlets (3-pin type) located within reasonable access of the playing site (25 feet or less) unless otherwise agreed upon and written in this Agreement below.
- This Agreement shall be governed in accordance with the laws of the State of Virginia. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid under the law, the other provisions will continue in force.
